Competitions are held according to Lithuanian Dressage rules (effective 2016), LŽSF competitions and other events organizing rules (effective 2010.01.22), LŽSF ethics rules (effective 2010.02.22), FEI Statutes 23rd edition (effective 2014.04.29), FEI General regulations 23rd edition (updates effective on 2017.01.01), LR veterinary requirements, FEI Anti-doping rules for human athletes (ADHRA) (effective on 2015.01.01)

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Riders from all countries are invited to participate in the competition:

- Children up to 14 y/o (inclusive on the competitions day, rider must be not older than allowed age)
- Juniors I group up to 16 y/o (inclusive)
- Juniors II group up to 18 y/o (inclusive)
- Youth up to 25 y/o (inclusive)
- 2. One horse can compete in not more than three competitions per day + competition for beginners or dressage test.
- 3. All horses must have passport with all the necessary examinations.
- 4. Riders up to 16 years old must wear protective vests.

5. Documents:

According to LT veterinary requirements: national horse passport, for rider's up to 18 y/o written parents agreement to participate in competitions. Riders up to 16 years old must wear protective vests.

6. Responsibility:

OC does not take any responsibility for material or physical damage, incidents, diseases or etc. which were faced by owners, athletes, grooms. Damage for horses, trainers, inventory, stabling accesorries and other property (including robberies) is not OC responsibility as well. We recommend to insure your property.

7. Draudimas:

All owners and athletes are responsible for the damage made for third parties, which were caused by their employees, agents or horses. We recommend to have third parties insurance which fully covers athelete's participation in horse competitions.

Test: E2

Rider's age: up to 14 years (inclusive)

Horse age: 6 years and older

Entry Fee: 15 EUR

Saddlery: Only ordinary bridle, whip is not allowed, spurs are not obligatory (max

3.5 cm), wearing helmet is compulsory at all times when mounted.

Prizes: 5 riders and trainer of the winner are awarded.

2. "SUMMER"

Test: M9

Rider's age: up to 25 years (inclusive)

Horse age: 6 years and older

Entry Fee: 18 EUR

Saddlery: Ordinary or double bridle, the use of whip with a maximum length of one

meter twenty (1.20 m) is allowed for horses and no longer than one meter for ponies (1 m), spurs are not obligatory, wearing helmet is compulsory

at all times when mounted.

Prizes: 5 riders and trainer of the winner are awarded.

3. Test P1

ATTENTION! Seperate class for rider's with "borrowed horsese" (wooden horses). Test is ridden "on your own legs". A group of people can participate at same time. No starting fee. Age up to 25 y/o.

5. "LADYBUGS". Competition for debutants.

Saddlery: Only ordinary bridle, the use of whip with a maximum length of one meter

who want to support their pupil, can run aside the debutant rider.

Classes: For riders debutants and riders debutants riding pony class horses.

Obstacles height: 20 - 50 cm **Starting fee:** 18 EUR

Conditions: Two riders can participate with one horse

Prizes: 5 riders and trainer of the winner are awarded. Also the best trio will

receive a prize

from each age categories (Children, Juniors I, Juniors II) and provides it to the Show Secretary on Saturday evening. Team consist of at least tree rider's from seperate age categories. Three best results are included in

final result.
