Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Horses: 6 yrs and older

Riders: 16-21 yrs

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Program no 4: FEI Juniors Team Competition (edition 2009), Junior Rider Championships

Horses: 6 yrs and older

Riders: 14-18 yrs

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat allowed.

Open class:

Horses: 6 yrs and older

Riders: 12 yrs and older, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs old horses.

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Program no. 5: FEI Children Team Competition (edition 2009), 14-16 yrs Championships

Riders: 14-16 yrs

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet for riding horses 6 yrs and younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Pony class:

Horses: max. 148 cm and 6 yrs and older

Riders: 12-16 yrs, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs old horses

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed (spurs max. 3,5 cm)

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Open class:

Horses: 4 yrs and older

Riders: 12 yrs and older, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs and younger horses.

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet riders 18 yrs or younger or for riding horses 6-years and younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Program no. 7: Horse evaluation in groups walk, trot, canter, 4 yrs old horse Championships

Horses: 4 yrs old.

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Program no. 8: FEI dressage test for 4-year old horses (edition 2005, updated 2009), 5 yrs old horse Championships

Horses: 5 yrs old

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Program no. 9: FEI dressage test for 5-year old horses (edition 2004, updated 2009), 6 yrs old horse Championships

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Horses: 8 yrs or older

Riders: 12 yrs or older

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Or: FEI Grand Prix Special (edition 2009, revision 2014)

Program no. 11: FEI Intermediate I (edition 2009), Senior Championships, Small Tour

Horses: 7 yrs or older

Riders: 12 yrs or older

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Or: FEI Freestyle to music Intermediate I (edition 1998, revision 2009)

Program no. 12: M level freestyle to music, Young Rider and Junior Rider Championships

Horses: 6 yrs or older

Riders: 16-21 yrs, 14-18 yrs

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Open class:

Horses: 6 yrs and older

Riders: 12 yrs and older, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs old horses.

Spurs compulsory, snaffle or double bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat allowed.

Or: FEI Juniors Preliminary Test (edition 2009)

Program no. 13: National test E3, Amateur Championships

Horses: 4 yrs and older

Riders: 19 yrs and older

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet riders for riding horses 6 yrs and younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Open class:

Horses: 4 yrs and older

Riders: 12 yrs and older, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs and younger horses.

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet riders 18 yrs or younger or for riding horses 6 yrs and younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Program no. 14: FEI World Dressage Challenge Elementary (edition 2011), 14-16 yrs Championships

Horses: 6 yrs and older

Riders: 14-16 yrs., 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs old horses.

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed.

Approved safety helmet for riders 18 yrs or younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Open class:

Horses: 4 yrs and older

Riders: 12 yrs and older, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs and younger horses.

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet riders 18 yrs or younger or for riding horses 6 yrs and younger, tailcoat not allowed.

Program no. 15: National test E1, 4 yrs old horse Championships

Horses: 4 yrs old.

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Program no. 16: National test E5, 5 yrs old horse Championships

Horses: 5 yrs old

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Program no. 17: FEI dressage test for 5-year old horses – Final (edition 2004, updated 2009), 6 yrs old horse Championships

Horses: 6 yrs old

Riders: 16 yrs and older

Spurs compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Program no 18: FEI World Dressage Challenge Preliminary test (edition 2011), Pony Championships

Pony class:

Horses: max. 148 cm and 6 yrs and older

Riders: 12-16 yrs, 16 yrs and older when riding 6 yrs old horses

Spurs not compulsory, snaffle bridle, no whip allowed (spurs max. 3,5 cm)

Approved safety helmet compulsory, tailcoat not allowed

Seniors, young riders and juniors will have a choice of a freestyle or technical test for the second day. The highest percentage will determine the placement, no matter which test the rider chooses.
